OPEN INVITATION TO ALL FGRS MEMBERS

The following is an update regarding details of the Florida Garden Railway Society's participation with LGBoA and the Union Pacific Railroad Company at Epcot's 2008 Flower & Garden Show 3/19 – 6/01.

Details of volunteering:

- The display will be inside in Garden Town (formerly Wonders of Life).
- The G-scale display will be about 16 X 20 along with 2 additional displays.
- Parking will be backstage through the same employee/service gate used in 2006. Photo ID (Drivers License, State ID or Passport) will be required. If your name is not on the schedule/calendar you will not be admitted. A map showing access to the BLUE PARKING LOT (vehicles will be towed if parked anywhere else) will be posted on the FGRS website.
- While in Epcot you are asked to wear your FGRS nametags.
- Hours on-stage are 11 am - 5 pm, although the display will be open until 7 pm.
- There is a break room (near the display) with a refrigerator and places to sit for 15-20 min. breaks.
- A minimum of 2 volunteers is requested. There will be a maximum of 4 meal vouchers (\$7 value) each day for lunch at the cast cafeteria.
- Dress code is casual, meaning that chinos and a collared shirt, jeans, RR caps and RR outfits are OK. We are asked that our attire is neat and our appearance be well-groomed (facial hair OK).
- For those requiring an overnight stay, there is a time-share suite available. It is located a short drive from Epcot at Westgate Leisure Suites, 6950 Villa De Costa Dr., Orlando, FL 32821, 407.239.8855. It is reserved in the name of Jack Lynch. It has 2 bedrooms, an eating area and washer & dryer (detergent will be provided) for clothing changes and to do the sheets before you leave. LGBoA will have the suite cleaned weekly. You can use the suite after 5:00 pm of the first day you work and you will have to vacate by 10:30 am on the last day you work. PLEASE bring the key back to Epcot when you check out. Return the key to Robert or Christine at the display. DO NOT leave it at the front desk!!
