



If you would like to bring a picnic lunch, there are seats and tables provided.

For those who have not been here before, here is a short description of the layout:

There is over 1900' of track located on over 1/2 acre. The railroad is mostly elevated off the ground. The trains travel along a 100' stream to and around a 30' oval pond. There is a 40' oval setup



elevated 4' off the ground for those who bring their trains to run. This also serves as a reversing loop for the main line.

This year we have a new addition for the children to run trains - a double track on a 16' oval that is elevated on a table top arrangement. The town will be decorated for Christmas with lots of lights so if you come later in the afternoon you will get the full effect.

As usual if you have a train to run feel free to bring it and we will work you into the traffic. Water and snacks will be available, and we will have a scavenger hunt for folks to find all



the hidden objects. Directions for out of town guests are as follows: I 75 exit SR 40 East through Ocala to NE 7th street. Just pass Ocala Golf Club turn right onto NE 7th street. Continue east on NE 7th to SR 35. (Baseline Road) cross over SR 35 continuing East to NE 61 Terrace. This is "Green Ridge Acres" development.


We started the day at the great garden railway at Nature Coast Botanical Gardens. Botanical Gardens Photos by Doug Brainard
